Since the election I have taken part in a number of debates in parliament covering a wide range of issues, as well as securing debates on Anti-bullying and The Year of Walking.

I have lodged several motions highlighting the work of individuals and organisations in the constituency, such as commemorating the 57th anniversary of the Auchengeich mining disaster. I have also used motions to condemn the attack on the Coatbridge Cenotaph and to raise awareness of the impact of miscarriage during baby-loss awareness week.

I am also a member of several cross-party groups. I am the convener of the CPG on Racial Equality and the deputy convener of the CPG on Children & Young People.

I take every opportunity to hold government ministers to account by submitting written and oral questions



I am a member of both the Justice and the Education & Skills Committees, which cover a wide range of issues affecting Coatbridge & Chryston.


